

Checklist for Moving with Houseplants

Pre-Move: 2-4 Weeks Before

- 1. **Inventory Plants**: List types, sizes, and needs. Decide what to move.
- 2. Inspect for Pests: Check and treat issues early.
- 3. Check Regulations: Research USDA rules for state borders; get certificates if needed.
- 4. **Prune/Repot**: Trim and switch to sturdy pots if necessary.
- 5. Acclimate: Reduce watering; simulate travel conditions.

Packing: 1-2 Days Before

- 1. **Supplies**: Get boxes, wrap, bags, and supports.
- 2. Water Wisely: Hydrate lightly; drain excess.
- 3. Secure: Bag pots to contain soil; cushion with padding.
- 4. Label: Mark "Fragile: Live Plants" with orientation.
- 5. Transport Plan: Use personal vehicle or climate-controlled services.

During Move

- 1. **Temperature Control**: Keep 50-80°F; avoid extremes.
- 2. Airflow/Light: Ventilate; provide indirect light.
- 3. Handle Gently: Secure to prevent shifting.

Post-Move

- 1. Unpack Quickly: Inspect for damage.
- 2. Rehydrate/Acclimate: Water lightly; shade initially.
- 3. Monitor Shock: Watch for wilting; quarantine pests.
- 4. **Settle In**: Delay fertilizing; adjust to new environment.

Tips

- For long distances, consider shipping or cuttings.
- Use eco-friendly materials.
